## Strengthening Our Impact in Quebec

Lung Cancer Canada is proud to be part of a major initiative shaping the future of cancer care in Quebec. In collaboration with the Quebec Cancer Coalition, we have contributed to a comprehensive report that outlines the key objectives and priorities for cancer care in the province over the next decade.

This report is designed to guide decision-makers, healthcare professionals, and policymakers as they work to implement Quebec's provincial cancer action plan. The primary focus is on:

- Reducing cancer incidence, mortality, and morbidity
- Enhancing the quality of life for patients and their families
- Addressing gaps in support and improving access to care

Lung Cancer Canada's involvement in this initiative highlights the unique challenges lung cancer patients face in Quebec, as well as existing gaps in support and care; key policy recommendations to improve early detection, treatment, and access; and essential performance indicators to measure progress.

By working alongside the Quebec Cancer Coalition, we are ensuring that lung cancer remains a top priority in the province's healthcare system.

# Advancing Lung Cancer Research: Our Commitment to Innovation and Hope

At Lung Cancer Canada, we believe in the promise that research represents — a promise of hope, innovation, and a better future for everyone impacted by lung cancer. Research saves lives. It has transformed patient outcomes, healthcare practices, and public health strategies, proving time and again that investment in lung cancer research is not just necessary — it's essential.

That's why Lung Cancer Canada is proud to support Canada's leading lung cancer researchers, providing critical funding to advance groundbreaking studies that will shape the future of lung cancer care. Over the past few months, we have funded several exciting new projects, and even more investments will be announced in the coming weeks!

## Recent Research Grants & Awards:

## **Geoffrey Ogram Memorial Research Grant**

Named in memory of Geoffrey Ogram, a dedicated lung cancer advocate, this grant supports innovative, high-impact lung cancer research in Canada. This year's recipients include:

- **Dr. Geoffrey Liu (Ontario)** Investigating novel biomarkers and treatment strategies for lung cancer.
- **Dr. Biniam Kidane (Manitoba)** Researching advancements in surgical and treatment techniques to improve patient outcomes.

#### Pfizer-LCC-LHF-APQ Awards in Lung Cancer Research

These awards support studies that aim to enhance patient care and quality of life through community-based interventions and digital health solutions:

- Dr. Enam Alsrayheen (Nova Scotia Health Authority, Cape Breton) Evaluating the effectiveness of implementing a community-based lung clinic at the Cape Breton Cancer Centre.
- Dr. Sylvie Lambert (St. Mary's Research Centre, Montreal) Developing patient-reported outcome measures to improve symptom management and self-care strategies for patients with metastatic non-small cell lung cancer.
- Dr. Erik Vakil (University of Calgary, Calgary) Patient preferences for the

management of malignant pleural effusions: A multi-centre discrete choice experiment

## **Lung Ambition Awards**

Lung Cancer Canada is proud to partner with AstraZeneca Canada and the Lung Ambition Alliance to fund research that aligns with our collective goal of eliminating lung cancer as a cause of death.

## **Give a Breath Research Awards (Coming Soon!)**

Launching this year, the Give a Breath Research Awards, supported by the Monds Family and the Give a Breath 5K, will provide critical funding to address gaps in post-first-line therapy for advanced lung cancer. The inaugural recipients of the awards, part of Lung Cancer Canada's commitment to accelerating lung cancer research, will be officially announced soon.
